

Just as diverse as hunting, so are the demands hunters place on their rifles. To say the R8 is just a bolt action rifle is the understatement of the century. More than just a rifle it is a platform that allows you the flexibility to interchange calibers while providing ergonomic perfection in stock design and unequaled trigger performance.

Blaser Precision Trigger

The desmodromic trigger mechanism guarantees your trigger will function even when iced or heavily soiled. The mechanical advantage of a simple lever will ensure success even in the harshest conditions. When things are going your way a trigger without creep, will turn that thought impulse into action.

Blaser Saddle Mount

Barrel and Saddle Mount form one accurate unit: Notches machined into the top of the barrel, directly above the chamber, insure while your barrel freely floats your point of impact remains constant.

Optimum Barrel Bedding

The large-scale bedding of the barrel exclusively in the solid receiver guarantees repeatable accuracy when exchanging the barrel.

Blaser Radial Locking System

Stability and reliable accuracy: The extremely strong, concentric locking system locks directly in the barrel without any rotary motion. 14 locking surfaces provide 360 degree engagement.

Forged Barrel and Chamber

Precision and durability: The barrel and chamber are cold hammer forged. Barrel and chamber are perfectly concentric.

The relaxed shooting position of the hand reduces the risk of flinching. Blaser stocks, with their distinct palm swell and optimal cast, provide the ideal grip. The thumbhole stocks of the R8 Success and R8 Ultimate models go even further: thanks to a completely relaxed wrist and arm posture, shooting accuracy is significantly enhanced in any firing position.

Manual Cocking System

For decades, Blaser's manual cocking system has set the benchmark. It is acknowledged as one of the safest in the world. There is no mechanical safety system that guarantees the safety of an uncocked firing spring. The R8 is cocked the very moment before shooting. Should the shot not be taken, by simply pressing down on the cocking lever, it will slide back smoothly, decocking the rifle.

Protection Against Misuse

If the R8 magazine with integrated trigger guard is taken out, the cocking lever cannot be set in the cocked position. This is without doubt the safest protection against unauthorized use!

No Unintentional Bolt Opening

If the R8 is decocked with a locked bolt, the bolt handle is blocked. To safely open the bolt, the cocking lever needs to be moved slightly forward (approx. 3mm / 1/8"), but not cocked, while simultaneously pulling back on the bolt handle.

The unique design of the R8 magazine above the trigger allows the overall length of the R8 to be significantly shorter than any conventional bolt action rifle.

Quick Take Down – Easily Cleaned

Even when in the bush, the R8 can be taken down and reassembled within a few seconds. Snow, dirt, leaves or needles are easily removed.

Desmodromic Trigger Mechanism

Maximum reliability – even when iced or heavily soiled. The trigger system of the R8 is force-controlled. Cycling the bolt automatically resets the trigger.

Locked Magazine

The R8 magazine is only released when simultaneously pressing both release buttons. Accidental drop out of the magazine by unintentionally pushing the release buttons is thus virtually impossible. In addition, both release buttons can be locked by a lever inside the magazine.

Excellently Protected

The closed construction of the R8 receiver prevents damage caused by foreign objects. When the magazine is stored outside the rifle, a protective cover keeps the dirt out. All metal parts are either made of rustproof material or protected against corrosion with a specific finish. The inside of the barrel and chamber are polished and need conventional care.

For perfect precision, every hunter needs a perfect companion: the Blaser R8 is more than just a rifle – it is a legend. This is the reason why we optimized the bolt-action rifle R8 for left-handed shooters.

The result: Almost every model of the Blaser R8 is now available as a true left-hand version: with a left-handed bolt handle, left-handed chamber and left-handed ejector. The ergonomic stock is available as a standard or as a success stock – either wooden or synthetic – and has also been specially adapted for left-handed shooters.

For shooters who like a maximum of flexibility, we offer the R8 Professional also with double palmswell – an ambidextrous option with a locking mechanism on the left and on the right.

SOUND OF SILENCE OUR SILENCER SOLUTIONS

Every shot can cause irreparable damage to your hearing. It is therefore advisable to wear suitable hearing protection at all times when shooting. Practical considerations when hunting means that this is not always possible. Using silencers represents the far better solution. They provide less risk of hearing damage and the pain threshold of 130 dB at the ear is rarely reached. Moreover, silencers have a particularly positive effect on the shooting performance. Besides the muzzle report, a silencer also considerably reduces recoil which is a significant part of achieving better accuracy.



R8 SILENCE MODELS

The construction of the R8 Silence is designed to protect the hearing of both hunter and dog. At any time and with every shot. Thanks to the even weight distribution of the entire barrel, the R8 Silence models provide the first-class balance and huntability that you are used with every R8 model. The outer contour of the barrel and silencer jacket boasts a smooth bull barrel design, giving the R8 Silence models their low weight and an extremely attractive overall appearance.

Baffle design and geometry is the heart of every silencer. It is largely responsible for reducing the recoil – and in combination with the large volume of the silencer – reducing the sound of the shot and protecting a shooter's hearing. For the Blaser Integral Silencer (ISD), the geometry was optimized to the maximum diameter – while still maintaining the overall aesthetic of the rifle itself.



Within a fraction of a second – all the processes take place inside the silencer – which ensure recoil reduction and noise dampening when the shot is fired. As an example, with a barrel length of 42 cm (16.5") in .308 Win, the projectile emerges from the muzzle at a velocity of 750 m/s. It passes completely through the length of the Integral Silencer in just 0.27 milliseconds.

The muzzle brake deflects a part of the gases rearward, in an evenly dispersed fashion. Like the outer tube, the muzzle brake is made of titanium, which ensures minimum weight and optimum durability. It is also responsible for ensuring that the Blaser Integral Silencer can be properly attached to the muzzle thread of the barrel. This allows the bullet to pass through the silencer without obstruction. With this high-strength material and its precise manufacturing – the problems with bullet striations and the resulting change in the point of impact are now a thing of the past.

The innovative design of the Blaser Integral Silencer allows for use of the entire length of the silencer as an expansion space for the powder gases – while maintaining its slim overall appearance. The inner tube of the Blaser Integral Silencer (ISD) contains and closes off the expansion chamber and keeps the gases from contacting the surface of the barrel itself. The barrel always remains clean and is reliably protected against powder residues, contamination and corrosive residues.

Every R8 and K95 can optionally be factory fitted and retro-fitted with the required muzzle thread for the silencer. Please note all barrels with sights require the front sight to be set back approximately 17 mm / 0.67".

It is also suggested to use a thread protector cap when the silencer is not installed.

Blaser Over-Barrel Silencer

The Blaser Over-Barrel Silencer is the ideal solution when short overall length is required. The combination of a special aluminum alloy and steel ensures it is lightweight while still having a long service life.

It should be taken into account that the Blaser Over-Barrel Silencer can only be mounted on barrels without open sights. For retrofitting a muzzle thread with cover, the front sight must be removed.

Then, with the development of illuminated reticles for daytime use, many manufacturers switched their reticle to the second focal plane. At the time, the luminous structures could not be made fine enough to be integrated into the first focal plane.

Thanks to Swiss phase grating technology it was possible to design very fine reticles in the first focal plane featuring a reticle illumination that is also suitable for daylight. While hunting, there are situations in which a long-range shot may become necessary. All well and good, when you are able to remain on target and don't have to hold over. The Quick Distance Control (QDC) was specially developed for this purpose. Its highly precise and extremely robust mechanics provide a consistently reliable return to zero.







Maximilian Ergert was lucky enough to have hunted in many countries throughout the world where he gained invaluable experience in his travels from northern Alaska to southern Africa. However, the importance of his hunts near home can't be overlooked. The countless hours spent hunting in the local mountain areas taught him how crucial it is to be fit and well equipped, so it is no surprise that Maximilian was one of the first customers to have his beloved, modular bolt-action R8 rifle fitted with a barrel in 8,5x55 Blaser caliber.

As much as Maximilian has been impressed by the untouched wilderness of the far north or the incomparable surroundings of the African bush, the Romanian Carpathians still fascinate him today. They are considered one of the last European refuges where hunting is still as authentic as it was in days of old, and among the most challenging on earth – requiring great instinct and skill. This is why Maximilian has been drawn to the wild Carpathians again and again over the years.

A spontaneous idea led to us accompanying Maximilian to the deer rut in the Carpathians last fall. Since his new Blaser single shot rifle in 8,5x55 Blaser caliber was to be used on this long-planned trip, it was the ideal opportunity for us to capture the hunt and his experience with this caliber on camera. The small team around Maximilian now consisted of Blaser camera man Max Sattler and the experienced Tyrolean professional hunter Otto Schratz, who supported the hunt and filming on site, as did another hunter who knew the area.→

ON THE MOVE WITH BLASER WORLDWIDE

Between tradition and modernity: Maximilian Ergert tells Gunther Stoschek in our interview about his experiences with and on the hunt in distant countries, but also in his home hunting ground. Always with him: his two Blaser rifles – the R8 Professional Success and the K95 Ultimate, both in 8,5x55 Blaser caliber.

Maximilian, you are one of the lucky ones who has been able to hunt in many countries on this earth. Why is it, that you are attracted so much by the Romanian Carpathians?

That's a long story. Maybe it has something to do with the fact that I was brought up very conservatively by my father when it comes to hunting. He had been the Director of the German Hunting and Fishing Museum in Munich for many years. Traditions were always very important to us in the mountains – no one dared to question them. I don't criticize traditions, on the contrary. But somehow, I always longed for primal, physically demanding hunting that wasn't primarily about shooting plan fulfillment or accepting a generous invitation for a trophy stag. Rather, I wanted to hunt more freely and originally, learning to rely on my own instincts. This is exactly the kind of hunting I found in the Carpathians.

How did your father see your hunting ambitions? Weren't there discussions?

Yes, of course. As is often the case between father and son. He already knew that I hunt properly, but he would never have accepted me accompanying him in camouflage clothing when we went stalking together, for example. It was simply against his tradition – although camo gear can be so useful and is an indispensable companion in many situations.

So you both surely also disagreed when it comes to hunting firearms?

Of course not. My father could never have imagined carrying a rifle with synthetic stock. For him, there was only the classic rifle with a wooden stock.

But wasn't there a moment when your father agreed with you?

Almost... Once he had to fulfill the shooting plan for red deer in a foreign hunting ground in late autumn and in bad weather. I don't remember exactly why, but he borrowed a rifle from me. Of all things, a rifle with a synthetic stock! Afterwards he still didn't like synthetic stocks, but at least he didn't demonize them anymore. That was probably due to the continuous rain during his hunt.

Maximilian, moving on to your favorite rifles, what do you value most today, with all your experience?

Absolute reliability and lasting shooting precision under all conditions. In this respect, my R8 with synthetic thumbhole stock is simply unbeatable. The fact that it is also very short is another advantage – especially when using silencers.

What about your preferred calibers?

I've tried a lot of different calibers, but I usually hunted with a .300 Win Mag, which was my first choice for larger game for a long time. The shooting performance of the 8,5x55 Blaser, however, has convinced me so much that I became weak once again.

What was the reason for this?

Today, I prefer to carry only one firearm with which I am thoroughly familiar. With the 8,5, I can hunt almost any type of game, especially since the caliber is available in a number of different bullet weights. In addition, the 8,5x55 Blaser has other advantages compared to the .300 Win. Mag. The larger bullet diameter, for example, is very advantageous, especially with lead-free bullets. In addition, the 8,5 has an amazingly high bullet velocity with short barrels. So even when using a silencer, I have a very compact rifle with a very elongated bullet trajectory.

But for the hunt in Romania, you treated yourself to a single shot rifle

Yes, there were two reasons for that. First, the K95 is lighter than my R8. With the eternally long paths in the Carpathians, the lighter weight rifles makes it much easier. Secondly, it can be disassembled faster and stowed even more conveniently in the backpack. But of course, I stayed with the 8,5x55 Blaser caliber. With regard to hunting in Europe, you can really say that this caliber does it all. Where else can you find that? —



IN THE MOUNTAINS OF ROMANIA HUNTING IS STILL AUTHENTIC.

When they left Munich, however, not even the mountain-experienced Otto could have predicted the hardships that they would soon face. Maximilian had explained the conditions in the Carpathians to his two companions in detail prior to the trip, but some things must be experienced to be fully understood. Otto and Max only became aware of this when they finally saw the vastness of the Carpathians for themselves. The region is hardly accessible by road, and both already knew that bears and wolves still keep the red deer population within manageable limits here. This would make hunting anything but easy and the adventure was made all the more challenging by attempting to capture everything on film.

Thanks to the experience and instinct of the hunters involved, Maximilian encountered a mature, stealthy stag late one evening, which he successfully shot. Anyone who sees these pictures will sense the tension that embraced Maximilian and his companions. Of course, the hunt was not over with the killing of this large stag. The heavy animal had to be recovered in this completely remote area, cut up and transported to the valley. Unfortunately, during this strenuous work in the darkness of night, a branch injured camera man Max's eye. He had to make the difficult descent off the mountain bleeding and barely able to see. Despite this mishap, and the fact that he was unable to take part in the subsequent hunt for Carpathian Chamois, the allure of the Carpathians will remain with him forever. —

LASER ENGRAVINGS OF THE THIRD DIMENSION

It is a machine that was not actually developed for the manufacturing of hunting firearms, but for the automotive industry, that is used today to create highly individual laser engravings that are unparalleled in terms of detail and depth.

The lion on the receiver of this R8 has a mane of such fine lines that it appears downright airy. This contrasts with the background, which has been lasered a few layers deeper and thus appears jet black. The highlight is the fineness, of the tiny, 1mm razor-sharp lines, which reaches the limits of what is possible. The removal of different numbers of layers not only creates the depth in the image, but also gives it an extraordinary feel.

Manual labor is nevertheless required for laser engraving. In the Blaser Custom Shop, master engraver Ralph Salzmann prepares and creates the image files for the laser by hand. This is done in initial sketches quite traditionally with paper and pencil, and later they are digitized on the drawing tablet.

In doing so, even relief-like representations are possible now. However, Ralph Salzmann has to "think" his way into every engraving from scratch in order to be able to create the different depths digitally. This is where his more than 20 years of experience as an engraver come in handy: he knows exactly what the engraving has to look like in the end.

Before production can begin, the image file must be prepared for the laser. To do this, it is divided into the three layers: Background, dithering (rasterization into dots) and grayscale. This usually takes much longer than the production on the machine itself.

From a portrait photo of a dog to textured alligator skin, laser technology can be used to reproduce anything that can be created digitally. Motifs become possible that previously would have been very time-intensive and difficult for the engraver to realize and with a very high time and thus very expensive for the customer.

In the Blaser Custom Shop, we are excited about the new possibilities that laser technology presents for the refinement of hunting rifles.

Ralph Salzmann (Master Engraver)

He comes from Suhl in Thuringia, the home of the world's finest gunsmiths. As a child, he dreamed of becoming a magician but his father made an engraver out of him. Ralph Salzmann is the artisan who, under contract with Jesse G. James, engraved Albrecht Dürer's Praying Hands onto Brad Pitt's pistol. Ralph Salzmann is artisan and hand craftsman, advisor and spin doctor, illustrator and perfectionist.

He is only satisfied when, with only a few strokes, he has given the impression that he has engraved thousands of blades of grass from the African veldt onto a bolt housing. He has mastered the art of reductionism. He has done this for the last 20 years, and during this time he has developed a distinctive style that is recognizable to experts in the field. He is the man for endowing almost magical emotions to the firearm. Could it be that, in his own way, he really has become a magician?





Despite its relatively low weight, the CDP bullet produces the optimum exit wound while causing minimum meat damage. Upon impact, the CDP bullet mushrooms symmetrically in four directions. Regardless of varying velocity and target resistance, the deformation process always remains controlled. When mushrooming, the diameter of the bullet increases by 2.5 times. 



ACTIVE PROTECTION OF SPECIES

Rhinos are poached for their horns and, as a result, are one of the most threatened species in the world. Blaser Safaris regularly makes great efforts to protect white rhinos against poachers and increase their population.





The escalating, worldwide demand for rhino horns causes the existential threat, although they cannot be legally sold or traded. CITES has the animal on its Level 1 list which means that a special permit is required to possess a rhino or rhino products. And even then, the horn may not be resold.

All of this has led to a huge black market in Asia. The rhino horn is reaching up to USD 160,000/kg – thanks to its use in some Chinese medicines and its status symbol for the wealthy. As a result, poachers find it worth the risk of entering private reserves and government-owned parks to kill rhinos. Those responsible for these lands in Africa are often left to their own initiatives to protect the rhinos because current laws are weak with minimal punishment for those who are caught and prosecuted. In essence, there is little deterrent for poachers.

At the Blaser Safaris Sney Rivier Lodge in Namibia, a 40-man security team monitors the endangered animals day and night. Although the patrol always acts with extreme caution, the night tour remains very dangerous, and many rangers have lost their lives in the fight against poachers. “When it comes to team safety, the most successful method of protecting the rhinos is dehorning,” says Conway Volek, Manager of Sney Rivier Lodge. This is a process where the rhino is darted by a vet. Then the horn is cut and the edges are smoothed off with a grinder. “This procedure is not painful for the rhino, and it is very much like us humans cutting our nails,” explains Conway Volek. “After that, the horn slowly grows back again.”

Just a two hour drive from Windhoek lies the lodge. Due to the clever design, the reed-covered main building can only be recognized when the vehicle stops a few meters in front of it. Even those who do not want to go hunting will get their money's worth here. This is ensured by the elegant rooms, excellent food, a swimming pool, and the possibility of observing antelope at the nearby waterhole from your own chalet.

The commitment is paying off. White rhinos have been living at Sney Rivier Lodge since 2008, and the population has developed so well that some animals have already been relocated to other nature reserves. "This is one way we contribute to the conservation of the species," explains the lodge manager. This commitment cannot be taken for granted, as keeping rhinos involves huge costs. In addition to protecting them against poaching, the animals also have to be fed in the years when the territory suffers from drought. And despite all the protective measures, Sney Rivier Lodge has already lost some rhinos to poachers. The good news: All poachers ended up in prison! Nevertheless: "When we find the poached rhinos dead with their horns hacked off, these are always heart-breaking moments," says Conway Volek.

In 2021, one of the regular dehorning actions for rhinos took place again at the Sney Rivier Lodge. Conway Volek and his team try to locate the wild animals in advance with the help of game cameras, so the rhinos can be approached directly by helicopter. Nkombe Rhino also participated in last year's campaign. The non-profit organization uses donations to support protection measures for rhinos in African national parks. The dehorning action is also used to tag the rhinos' ears for identification and insert a microchip, so they can be identified more easily in the future. →

THE BEST METHOD TO PROTECT THE RHINOS IS DEHORNING.



At the operating site, the transporters come together. Until the anesthesia takes effect, the team makes sure that the rhino does not get injured. After that, the grey giants are examined and measured.



All obtained data of an animal flow into a scientific database and allow a long-term view of the population development.

But first, the wild animals have to be found. To do this, a helicopter flies grid lines over the selected area. When a rhino comes into sight, the pilot manoeuvres the helicopter so that the vet can shoot a dart. When the rhino is darted, the ground crew is called in to start the process of making sure the rhino safely lies down. It takes about 15 minutes for the drug to take effect, so the ground crew must make sure the rhino does not put itself in danger. But even when it is safely on the ground, the team must continue to care for it. They must keep pouring water on the rhino to keep the body temperature down. The breathing also must be monitored.


Once the horns have been cut, the ears tagged, and the microchip inserted, DNA samples are taken. These samples are entered into an international database and used for scientific purposes. Once the work on the rhino has been done, the vet gives it a drug reversal injection, and the team slowly helps the rhino stand and walk again before waking it up completely. "There is a lot of effort put into the management and protection of these 'prehistoric' animals, which cannot defend themselves," says Conway Volek. "We want and need to direct all of our efforts toward their protection in order to preserve this species for future generations."

Wildlife and nature conservation are at the center of all we do at Blaser Safaris and a key factor in the selection of our partners. "That's why we get to know our partners' hunting grounds and their wildlife management from personal experience," says Blaser Safaris Managing Director, Rainer Schwarz. "In this context, even conservation organizations that are otherwise rather critical of hunting confirm that few things are more conducive to wildlife conservation than regulated hunting carried out in a sustainable manner." This also applies to the rhinos in Namibia where income from hunting helps fund conservation measures for them. —

Here you can stalk red deer all day long, and trophy fees are not high. Memorable hunts are the result of the skill and fitness of the hunter and his guide rather than the size of one's wallet.

IRELAND

The Call of the "Emerald Isle"

-  Ireland is known as the "Emerald Isle", due to the lush green nature of its wild romantic countryside. Hunting sika deer here is a very special experience. During the rut from the end of September, you can hear the shrill whistles of the "black devils" almost all day long in the remote high valleys. This gives you a wonderful sense of freedom from worldly cares as you set off in search of sika, which can be very large here. Stalking wild goats also presents a very exciting yet cost-effective way of hunting in Ireland.

In the Land of the Ibex


-  Hunting for ibex is the crowning glory in Spain – and there are four different subspecies on the Iberian Peninsula. The Gredos ibex is found in the Sierra de Gredos, which lies around 200 km west of Madrid. It is the most well known of the four species. The others are the Beceite ibex, from the Beceite mountains north of Valencia; the Sierra Nevada ibex from Andalusia; and the Ronda

ibex from the Ronda mountains. All four species are highly desirable trophies.

The hunting season for all four ibex species runs from October to the end of May. Hunting during the rut from the middle of November to the middle of December is highly recommended, or from April when bucks group together in small packs.

Along with ibex, Spain also offers opportunities for combined hunts, having good stocks of red and fallow deer, chamois and aoudad sheep in its various regions.





FINLAND

Hunting among Friends



In Finland you find a beautiful landscape and very friendly people.



Finland offers the hunts for whitetail, moose, grouse species like black grouse as well as capercaillie.



Whitetails are mostly hunted from the high seat. This can last until the late evening and is a unique experience – especially in the snow! Hunting moose takes place individually on the high seat or as a driven hunt: You may hunt bulls, cows and calves. The traditional nordic hunt for grouse species in the snow is hunting them in the treetops with the help of elk-hounds – either with a snowmobile or on skis.

ESTLAND

Indian Summer and Strong Moose



Hunting in the colorful Estonian forests in fall is a special experience. When the leaves turn from green to red, yellow, and bright orange, the northernmost, Baltic country invites hunters to pursue the Estonian elk. The hunt is a combination of sitting and stalking from the middle of September till the end of October – and the hunt for stag, roe deer and wild boars can be combined, too. Due to the longer contiguous forests for larger distances you need to go by car.
